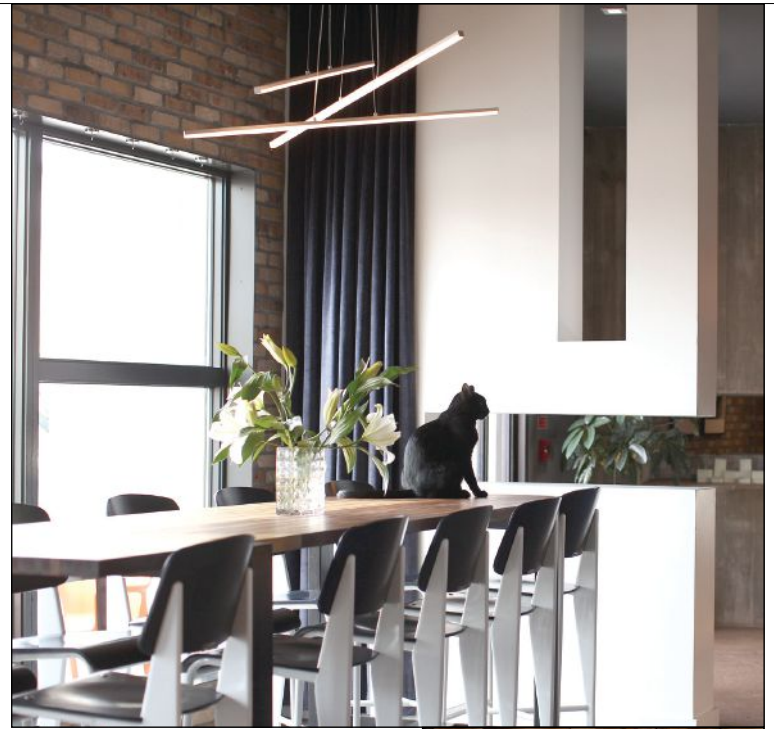

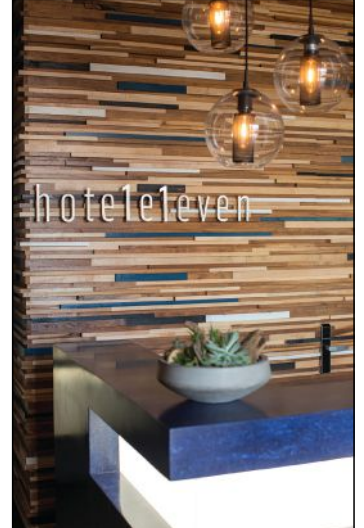

Cool cats and a kitty

Austin's boom in boutique hotels knows no limits, and one to check out is the 14-room **Hotel Eleven**, which puts guests right in the middle of Austin's East Side neighborhood — often preferred over crowded SoCo. On-site, Louie's Lounge brings in a steady crowd for coffee talk, daily happy hour, Friday night wine flights, bar bites (don't miss the caramelized mushroom-white cheddar dip with crostini) and visits with the black hotel cat, Louie. Eleven doubles as an art gallery, featuring local artists' work in the "Living Room." Guest rooms — all contemporary in style with clean lines, plush mattresses and SFERRA linens, wood details and bursts of color — vary in size from the small Crash Pad to the Prime Junior Suite. You're just steps away from shopping (Helm Boots, Gadabout Goods, Tiny Taiga), some of Austin's best food (Hillside Farmacy) and a happening cocktail scene (Nickel City).
